Through the welcoming entrance hall there is a grand reception room featuring exposed wooden beams, high ceilings, a wood burner and double doors to the picturesque rear garden. There is a stunning kitchen/breakfast room with ample storage and exposed brick walls. The ground floor is completed with a utility room, cloakroom and a light-filled second reception room all accessed from the kitchen/breakfast room.











On the first floor there is an impressive principal bedroom and en-suite bathroom with 'his and her' sinks. There are three further generously sized bedrooms and a modern four piece family bathroom.

Outside, there is a tranquil garden featuring a patio area with a delightful pond and a lawn garden with shrubbery and matured borders. The property is located close to the River Chess and bordered by natural woodland. Viewing is highly recommended to appreciate the size of this property.

The Metropolitan and Chiltern line train services connect you to London Baker Street, Marylebone Station and beyond. 


